Feeding guide

- Commence feeding at a rate of 0.5% of body weight / head / day. Increase gradually over a 3 week period to 0.75 – 1.0% of body weight or at rate required to achieve target feeding goals.
- Ensure good quality roughage such as pasture, hay or straw is available at all times.
- Feed in troughs, feeders or trail on the ground. Quality, large pellets able to be fed on the ground.
- When feeding in self feeders, pellet intake can be regulated by maneuvering the shutters. Lowering the shutters will reduce intake.
- Ensure sufficient trough space to minimise competition.
- Ensure supply of fresh, clean drinking water at all times.
- This pellet can be used for both cattle and sheep.

Storage - Store in a cool, dry place
